



#### <u>Selwyn Evans: 1938 – 2022</u>

Cafodd y gymuned gyfan sioc wrth glywed â thristwch am farwolaeth sydyn Selwyn Evans, Coedhirion, a oedd i fod yn Llywydd Sioe Llanddarog eleni. Symudodd i Landdarog gyda'i rieni yn ifanc iawn, ond yn 15 oed gadawodd yr ysgol i weithio ar fferm laeth y teulu. Datblygodd Selwyn a'i dad fuches Hirion o Friesian Prydeinig pedigri a'r fuches hon oedd y gyntaf yng Nghymru i gael ei chydnabod yn swyddogol fel un yn rhydd o Frwselosis. Roedd eu gwartheg yn adnabyddus yn yr ardal ac enillodd rhai o'r stoc pedigri glod mawr yng nghylch y sioe ac ennill yn y Sioe Frenhinol ar sawl achlysur. Gwyddom hefyd am gyfraniad helaeth Selwyn i'r Sioe Frenhinol ac i Amaethyddiaeth yn ei chyfanrwydd dros y blynyddoedd. Bu'n Uwch Sylwebydd Da Byw yng nghylch y gwartheg yn Sioe Frenhinol Cymru am dros ddeng mlynedd ar hugain ac yn y Ffair Aeaf Frenhinol am 25 mlynedd. Gosododd safon uchel o ddwyieithrwydd yn y dyletswyddau hyn. Roedd Selwyn yn gyn-aelod o'r Bwrdd Cyfarwyddwyr a'r Cyngor, ac yn gyn-Gadeirydd Pwyllgor Ymgynghorol Sir Gaerfyrddin. I gydnabod ei wasanaeth i'r Sioe Frenhinol dyfarnwyd ef yn Aelod Cysylltiol CGCAB yn 2017 ac yn 2019 dyfarnwyd Islywyddiaeth Oes y Gymdeithas iddo. Ef hefyd oedd y Darpar Gadeirydd ar gyfer 2022 ar gyfer Siambr Amaethyddiaeth Caerfyrddin.

Mae Selwyn wedi gwneud cyfraniad enfawr i fudiad y Clybiau Ffermwyr Ifanc ers degawdau lawer. Daliodd nifer o swyddi yng Nghlwb Llanddarog dros y blynyddoedd – Cadeirydd, Ysgrifennydd, Arweinydd a yna yn Llywydd. Daeth hefyd yn Gadeirydd y Sir ac yn ddiweddarach yn Llywydd y Sir a Chadeirydd Clybiau Ffermwyr Ifanc Cymru. Roedd yn Siaradwr Cyhoeddus ardderchog, sgil a gafodd unwaith eto o fod yn aelod o'r CFfl.

Penodwyd yn Drefnydd CFfl Sirol i Ffederasiwn Sir Gaerfyrddin, swydd a ddaliodd am 7 mlynedd a hanner. Roedd yn falch o holl lwyddiannau'r mudiad CFfl, ac roedd yn un o'r rhai a fu'n gyfrifol am adleoli Pencadlys CFfl Cymru i Lanelwedd.

Trwy ei gysylltiad â'r CFfl y cyfarfu â Daphne ac fe briodon nhw yn 1982 yn Eglwys Pembridge. Byddai Daphne a Selwyn wedi dathlu eu penblwydd priodas Rhuddem ym mis Medi eleni. Bendithiwyd hwy gan enedigaeth Tomos a gyda'i gilydd fel teulu yng Nghoedhirion fe arallgyfeirion nhw a sefydlwyd Gwersylla Teithiol hynod lwyddiannus, ac agorodd Selwyn y fferm i bobl o bob rhan o'r byd. Roedd ei braidd o ddefaid Texel yn cael ei hystyried fel un o'r radd flaenaf nid yn unig yng Nghymru ond y tu hwnt.

Chwaraeodd Selwyn ran fawr ym mywyd y fro hon. Roedd yn un o sylfaenwyr Sioe Llanddarog ac yn Ddarpar Lywydd ar gyfer 2022; cadeirydd ac aelod o bwyllgor y Neuadd am flynyddoedd lawer, ac yn aelod o'r Cyngor Cymuned am dros ddeng mlynedd ar hugain ac wedi gwasanaethu fel cadeirydd deirgwaith. Ef oedd yr un a awgrymodd fod gennym ni Wobr Gymunedol. Ef hefyd oedd yn gyfrifol am drefnu ymweliad Ei Uchelder Brenhinol Tywysog Cymru â'n pentref pan enillodd Llanddarog Wobr Pentref y Flwyddyn Cymru Gyfan yn 2003.

Roedd yn berson eglwysig pybyr a gwasanaethodd Sant Twrog, sef ei gartref ysbrydol, fel warden yr Eglwys am flynyddoedd lawer.

Roedd Selwyn hefyd yn gyn-aelod o'r Rotari, yn gyn Lywydd ac wedi derbyn Cymrawd Paul Harries. Yr oedd yn aelod presennol o Probus Caerfyrddin.

Mae cyfraniad Selwyn i amaethyddiaeth leol, cenedlaethol a rhyngwladol ar hyd y blynyddoedd yn eithriadol a bydd colled fawr ar ei ôl mewn cymaint o ardaloedd.

Cydymdeimlwn â Daphne a Tomos a holl aelodau'r teulu yn eu colled trist.





The whole community were shocked and saddened by the sudden death of Selwyn Evans Coedhirion who was to be the President of Llanddarog Show this year. He moved to Llanddarog with his parents at a very early age, but at the age of 15 left school to work on the family dairy farm. Selwyn and his father developed the Hirion herd of pedigree British Friesian and the herd was the first in Wales to be officially recognised as Brucellosis free. Their cattle were well known in the area and some of the pedigree stock won many accolades in the show ring and won at the Royal Welsh on numerous occasions. We also know of Selwyn's vast contribution to the Royal Welsh Show and to Agriculture as a whole over the years. He was a Senior Livestock Commentator in the cattle ring at the Royal Welsh Show for over thirty years and in the Royal Winter Fair

for 25 years. He set a high standard of bilingualism in these duties. Selwyn was a former member of the Board of Directors and Council, and a past Chairman of Carmarthenshire Advisory Committee. In recognition of his service to the Royal Welsh he was awarded CARAS Associateship in 2017 and in 2019 was awarded the Society's Life Vice Presidency. He was also the Chairman Designate for 2022 for the Carmarthen Chamber of Agriculture.

Selwyn has made a vast contribution to the Young Farmers Club movement over many decades. He held numerous offices at Llanddarog Club during the years — Chairman, Secretary, Leader and eventually President. He also became County Chairman and later County President and the Chairman of Wales Young Farmers' Clubs. He was an excellent Public Speaker, a skill that he again gained from being a YFC member.

He was appointed County YFC Organiser for the Carmarthenshire Federation, a post he held for 7 and a half years. He was proud of all the achievements of the YFC movement, and he was one of those responsible for relocating the Wales YFC Headquarters to Llanelwedd.

It was through his connection with the YFC that he met Daphne and they got married in 1982 at Pembridge Church. Daphne and Selwyn would have celebrated their Ruby wedding anniversary this coming September. They were blessed by the birth of Tomos and together as a family at Coedhirion they diversified and established a very successful Touring Campsite, and Selwyn opened up the farm to people from all over the world. His Texel sheep flock was regarded as top class not only in Wales but beyond.

Selwyn played a major role in the life of this locality, he was a founder member of Llanddarog Show and was President Designate for 2022; chairman and member of the Hall committee for many years, a member of the Communty Council for over thirty years having served as chairman on three occasions. He was the one who suggested we have a Community Award. He was responsible for arranging the visit to our village by His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales when Llanddarog won the All Wales Village of the Year Award in 2003.

He was a staunch church person and served St Twrog, which was his spiritual home, as Church warden for many years.

Selwyn was also a former member of Rotary, a past President and had received the Paul Harries Fellow. He was a current member of Carmarthen Probus.

Selwyn's contribution to both local, national and international agriculture over the years is exceptional and he will be sorely missed in so many quarters.

We sympathise with Daphne and Tomos and all family members in their sad loss.

#### RHEOLAU – RULES



- 1. The Society shall be called "Cymdeithas Sioe Amaethyddol Llanddarog a'r Cylch" "The Llanddarog and District Agricultural Show Society".
- Principal objectives of the Society shall be the improvements of the breeds of livestock, the development of agriculture generally and to hold an annual exhibition and if the Society so decides, to combine other classes as it finds necessary.
- The Society shall consist of a President, President-Elect, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Subscribers, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Financial Secretary.
- 4. The officials of the Society shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting and all appointments shall be for one year only, apart from the chair which is a two-year election. The retiring officers and one third of the Committee shall retire annually by rotation but shall be eligible for re-election at the Annual General Meeting.
- The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be held in the month of September of each year, to which all subscribers and the officials of the previous Show will be invited.
- The Annual General Meeting in appointing a committee, the number to be decided at the meeting, will invest in the Committee powers as it may be necessary for the running of the forthcoming Show. A quorum of the Committee shall consist of five.
- 7. The rules of the Society shall and only be altered by a General Meeting of the Society.
- Subscribers of £10 and over will be entitled to vote at the Annual General Meeting.
- A list of the year's subscribers will be printed in the next year's Schedule in a format compliant with GDPR and subscriptions for the current year will close on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
- 10. An account up to 31st August each year will be presented at the Annual General Meeting.
- 11. The Annual General Meeting, if it so desires, may appoint Patrons and Hon. Life Members.
- 12. The funds of the Society shall be utilized solely for the purpose of maintaining the objectives of the Society and Charities.

#### GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY INFORMATION

The Llanddarog and District Show Society, 'the society', exonerates itself from any loss, damage and neglect of Stall holder's effects and personal property. Stallholders will be responsible for Health and Hygiene, keeping their stand area safe and tidy at all times and to be left in the state that they found it. All rubbish to be cleared and taken away. The safety of the general public must be upheld at all times. Cars will be parked on the show field in a designated area during show day, and at the owner's risk. Cars will not be allowed on the showground during the evening event.

The organiser's decision will be final and will be upheld.

#### **Stewards**

These will assist with the implementation and enforcement of this policy statement and take charge in dealing with emergencies and major incidents.

#### Safety Officer. (Contact Emyr Williams 07967 195864)

Their duties include

- a. Inspection of exhibitor's stands and equipment.
- Enforcement of the Society's standards.
- Inspection of potential trouble spots in regard to movement of vehicles, livestock and people.
- d. Auditing and monitoring of documentation

#### Exhibitor's responsibilities

All exhibitors must take reasonable care for the health and safety of themselves and all other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions. No exhibitor may misuse, fail to use or recklessly interfere with any equipment provided by the organisers in the interests of health and safety under statutory obligations or otherwise.

All exhibitors should note the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1992, which requires co-operation and co-ordination between all exhibitors and the Society in so as far as the requirements on both to carry out adequate risk assessments covering the work to be carried out, and to implement any procedures as required by the above legislation, and also to inform all those concerned of these assessments and procedures.

#### Animals/Machines/People

Wherever possible traffic systems will be planned and operated. Ideally rigid crowd barriers or roped ways will be used to prevent people and the movement of animal intermixing. Only the minimum necessary movement of vehicles will be allowed. The speed limit of 5mph will be strictly enforced. Only exhibitors' vehicles will be permitted to enter the area in front of the marquee for a minimal amount of time for the purpose of unloading between 7.30am and 9.30pm prior to moving to the car park area. No vehicles, of any type, shall be driven, ridden, or pedalled around the Showground from 9.30am unless officially authorised or accessing or exiting the car parking areas. Vehicles must at all times be driven by a properly licensed and fully insured driver. Vehicles parking on site must not obstruct emergency exits or emergency routes.

Dogs should be kept on short leads at all times – Dogs must not be left unattended or in vehicles. All dog owners must dispose of their dog faeces safely. The movement of Cattle, Sheep & Goats must be kept to a minimum and when moving outside of their fenced areas, strictly controlled and stewarded. Horses must not be taken into any area where the public have access, except within the confines of the 'Horse Field'. Riders to wear a hard hat meeting current British Standard specification as specified by the British Horse Society.

In the event of an injury or illness of an animal, a veterinary surgeon and Farrier will be in attendance and can be contacted via the Secretaries tent.

#### Livestock Vehicle Movements at Close of Show

Livestock vehicle loading and movement will commence at 2.30pm. Livestock vehicles will leave the site at the bottom entrance to minimise risk to the public and to satisfy our control measures for segregation of traffic and the general public in convoys and all vehicle movements will be subject to stewarding and barriers being in place.

#### Machinery

Any plant, machinery or equipment used prior to, during or after the event should only be operated by an adult whom is fully trained in its safe use. Any use of equipment by persons under 18 should be prohibited.

All machinery should comply with the 'Provision and Use of Equipment Regulations 1998'.

When positioning ropes, fences and barriers to restrict the access of persons into potential danger areas, an adequate margin of safety must be observed. In particular, account must be taken of risks to those persons from materials which may be ejected from machines. All static exhibits must be erected in a way that ensures they do not present a risk to any person during the event (including erection and dismantling).

The correct protective clothing/equipment should be worn at all times when participants or exhibitors are engaged on any activity for which protective clothing/equipment is required. All such Protective clothing/equipment at should comply with the requirements of the Personnel Protective Equipment at Work Regulation 1992.

#### Children's Entertainment

Entertainment devices must comply with 'HSG175 Fairgrounds and Amusement Parks – Guidance on Safe Practice'. They must be run by qualified adults, provided with the necessary safety fences and operated within the designated areas. Inflatable play equipment must have an up to date ADIP/PIPA (or equivalent) inspection tag/certificate See Special Rules. Documentation should be available on site. The Society reserve the right to audit this documentation.

#### **Hazardous Equipment and Substances**

Particular care must be taken with the following potentially hazardous equipment.

- LPG Cylinders & Burners Cylinders must be safely and securely stored.
   Compressions fittings. Burners must be suitably sited and must have been examined and tested by a competent person and satisfactorily labelled to that effect.
   Documentation must be available for inspection on request.
- Electrical Generators These must be silent running, properly earth and protected by an approved RCD Trip System. Leads and cables should be dug into the ground, the hot exhaust must be suitable directed and the generator must have been recently tested and labelled to that effect.

#### Catering

All static/model caterers must ensure that they comply with all the relevant Food Hygiene Regulations:-

The Food Hygiene (General) Regulations 1970.

The Food Hygiene (Markets, Stalls and Delivery Vehicle) Regulations 1993

The Food labelling Regulations 1993

The Food Safety (General Food Hygiene) regulation 1991

The Health and Safety (Temperature Control Regulations) 1991

Health and Safety at Work Act 1974

All cateriers should realize that the inspectors of Local County Environmental Health Departments may make inspections prior to and during the event, to ensure that 'Food Operators' understand and comply with the relevant legislation.

Guidance on Health and safety in kitchens and food preparation are HS(G)55 is available from HMSO Tel 071 873 0011. Caterers should obtain a copy and follow the guidance therein.

#### Show and Stand Safety

All temporary structures including marquees etc must be soundly erected for their intended purpose and ensure that they are secured against any form of collapse. Trade exhibits are to keep strictly within their allocated site, in order to ensure the free flow of spectators and if necessary, emergency vehicles. Exhibitors' vehicles which cannot be accommodated within the allocated space are to be removed to the public car park by 9.30am. Trade Stands should refer to Trade Stands Regulations.

#### Fire

It is recommended that all trade stands have firefighting equipment that should be appropriate to tackle the risk involved as determined by their risk assessment.

All stands should allow enough room around their stand in case of emergency evacuation.

#### **Fire Emergency Procedure**

- 1. In the event of a fire evacuate the stand immediately
- 2. The alarm should be raised and neighbouring stand holdes warned of the danger

- Report the fire to the Secretary's tent where a telephone is available, and the fire authority will be called
- 4. Keep all spectators clear of the area
- All trade stands are required to have their own appropriate fire extinguisher(s) available for use at all times, and in accordance with the control measures outlined in their specific risk assessment

#### Accidents/First Aid

It is important that any accident should immediately be reported to the Secretary's Office, so that appropriate action can be taken with regard to emergency services and so that it can be recorded in the Accident Book.

First Aid is available at the St John's Ambulance.

#### Lost Children/Vulnerable Adults

Arrangements are in place for any children or vulnerable adults who become separated from their party to be taken to a place of safety.

#### **Smoking**

Smoking is not permitted in any marquee or other structure erected for use on show site, including toilets and grandstands. Smoking is also not permitted in any area where hay, straw or other bedding is stored. If smoking in any other area please ensure that you dispose of cigarette ends safely and without causing litter or the potential for ignition.

Radio communication is available to specified Show Stewards and personnel – a list of radios and channels is available from the Show Office

#### AMODAU - CONDITIONS

- 1 No entries accepted without entry fees.
- 2 All classes are open unless otherwise stated.
- 3 All exhibits for competition must be bona-fide property of the exhibitor at least one month prior to the Show.
- 4 No person will be allowed in the ring during the judging except the President, Stewards, Officials, Judge and one person in charge of the exhibits.
- All objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within one hour of the judging of the particular class, stating the grounds on which the objection is made, and any person lodging an objection must deposit £20.00 with the Secretary, which sum will be withheld if the objection is found to be frivolous, and all objections and questions of dispute shall be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final and from which there shall be no appeal, legal or otherwise.
- 6 All horses must be available to be measured on show field.
- In all cases of brood mares, it shall not be compulsory upon the exhibitor to exhibit the foal, but he /she must produce a veterinary certificate to the effect that the mare has produced a foal during the current year.
- A cow or heifer over two years old must be certified at the time of entry or be in-milk or in-calf. If in-calf and not in-milk, the cow or heifer must calve within three months of the date of the Show.
- 9 All cups won this year to be returned in a good condition to the Cup Secretary by 1st June next year. The holders of the cups will compensate the Committee for any loss or damage to the cups. The Committee will re-present replicas in the case of Perpetual cups, for an exhibitor winning three times in succession.
- All persons found entering the Show Field except through the entrance will be at once given in charge.
- 11 The Committee shall have the power to settle any matter which may arise, and which is not covered by the foregoing rules.
- 12 Children MUST wear a hard hat conforming to current standards in all best turned out and young handler classes.
- All exhibitors are responsible for presenting their exhibits.
- 14 All dogs to be on a lead.
- Should weather conditions make it impossible to hold the Show, entry fees will be refunded, but the Committee cannot accept responsibility for the expenses incurred by exhibitors. The Show will be held unless conditions are so bad that it would be unreasonable to ask exhibitors to subject the available livestock to the conditions of the day.
- 16 A £2 fee is to be paid by each exhibitor for the provision of St. John's Ambulance service, as detailed on the Entry Form.

The Show and its competitors will abide by the rules and recommendations set out within the appropriate breed society in relation to their class. Misconduct must be reported in writing only to the Show Secretary no later than 24 hours from the day of the Show.

'Only undocked dogs and legally-docked dogs may be entered for exhibition at this show'.

#### **LLANDDAROG FAIR CAKES**

Llanddarog was situated on one of the drover's routes and a major ingredient of the cakes was beer. This helped keep them in good condition for a long time on the drovers' journey to markets or better grazing land.

Ingredients (for approximately 6 cakes):

12 oz / 350 grams self-raising flour

8 oz / 225 grams butter

6 oz / 175 grams sugar

3-4 tablespoons beer

4oz / 110 grams currants, sultanas, raisins or mixed fruit

#### Method:

Mix the flour and sugar together and rub in the butter, mix in the beer to form a soft dough. Roll out on a floured board to a thickness of quarter to half inch thickness. Cut into rounds and press the fruit into the surface. Cook in a moderate oven (375 deg F / Mark 5) for about 15 minutes.
